

ARTHUR UNOBSKEY

Arthur H. Unobskey, 56, died December 26, 1955 in Calais, Maine.

A civic, business and Democratic leaders, Mr. Unobskey had suffered from a heart ailment for about a year.

Mr. Unobskey was born on June 6, 1898 in Russia. Unsure of his birth date, he adopted December 25th with his brother-in-law Morris Holland. He entered his father's business-Unobskey's Department Store in Calais, 35 years ago and became its owner.

Mr. Unobskey was a force. He had been chairman of the Maine Chamber of Commerce and the Washington County Chamber of Commerce and was a member of the Maine Development Commission, the Rotary Club and Odd Fellows.

He was also a member of the International Board of Trade and had been a delegate to President Truman on behalf of the Passamaquoddy International Tidal Power Project. He was a leader in both county and state politics.

Mr. Unobskey is survived by his wife Lillian (Rudman) Unobskey of Calais; two sons, Joseph and Sidney of Calais; a daughter, Martha Goldner of Nashville, Tennessee; and two brothers, Charles Unobskey of Calais and Dr. William Unobskey of New York City
