Mary Unobsky

Mary (Cholodny) Unobsky 53, died early in the morning of January 23, 1940 following several weeks of illness at her home in Lubec.

Born in Russia in 1887, Mrs. Unobsky lived more than 40 years in the United States, initially in Lubec and then Newport, Vermont and then Akron, Ohio before returning to Lubec.

As reported by the Lubec Herald, she was "...a quiet and retiring woman, devoted to her family and home, faithful in her religious faith and enjoying the respect of all."

Surviving is her husband Louis, owner of Unobsky's store in Lubec, a son, Bert of Greensboro, North Carolina; two daughters, Mrs. Anne Fitterman of Akron, Ohio and Dora Unobsky of Lubec. She also leaves a sister, Sarah Unobskey of Calais and a brother, Morris Holland, also of Calais
