BANGOR — Solomon Goos, 87, died March 25, 1982, at an Orono nursing home. He formerly resided at 94 Court St., Bangor. Mr. Goos was born in Poland in 1894, the son of Zussa and Bella Goos. He came to the United States in 1919 and was a self-employed livestock dealer all his life. Mr. Goos also was a member of Congregation Beth Israel and Beth Israel Chavra Kadisha Committee.
