Barney Silver, Well Known Orono Auto Dealer, Dies

Barney Silver, 74, well-known Orono businessman died Tuesday morning at a local hospital following a long illness.

He was born in Poland, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Judah Wolfe Zilbert and came to this country as a young man. He had made his home in Orono for more than 50 years, being originally engaged there in the cattle and horse business. He was well-known throughout the state in that capacity, and for the past 15 years had been associated in business with his sons in Silver's Auto Company, which he established and of which he was president.

He was a member of the Congregation Toldos Itzchock, and was active in the charitable work of the community.

Mr. Silver is survived by his wife, Sarah Goldberg Silver, four sons, George and Abraham, both of Bangor, Louis, of Veazie and Alex, of Presque Isle, two daughters, Mrs. Dorothy Serota of Orono and Mrs. Lillian Schwartz of Bangor, 13 grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.
