**BENJAMIN SHUR**

The community was grieved and shocked Saturday morning, to learn of the tragic death of Benjamin Shur, which occurred in Danforth, Friday evening about ten o'clock. He was born in Island Falls, Aug. 1916, the son of Mrs. Ida Shur and the late Ruben Shur. He was a graduate of the Island Falls high school and always popular with his associates, an outstanding student.
