Bangor Jewish Teacher Of Past 30 Years Dies At Sister's Saco Home

The remains of Jacob David Leavitt, Hebrew scholar and teacher in Bangor for the past 30 years, and a resident of the city for the past 40 years, were brought to Bangor yesterday from Saco where he died Wednesday night at the home of his sister, Mrs. David Robinson.

Funeral services were held from the home of Mrs. David Braidy, 138 Birch street, at 3:30 yesterday afternoon, Rabbi Milton Elefant officiating. Bearers were Abraham Stern, Max Kominsky, Leo Brown, and David Goldberg. Interment was the Congregational Beth Israel cemetery.
