BANGOR — Allan Cohn, 82, a prominent retired businessman, died April 5, 1989, at a Bangor hospital, after a brief illness. Mr. Cohn was born in Bangor, July 6, 1907, the son of Samuel M. and Dora (Kapelovich) Cohn. He was a graduate of Bangor High School, Class of 1924, and retired as owner after 50 years with the Allen-Lewis Men's Store on Main Street in Bangor. He was a former member of the Bangor Merchant's Association, was an avid fisherman and had shown great interest in politics.
