

DR. ARTHUR A. LIPSKY

Dr. Arthur A. Lipsky, 71, of 115 Essex Street, died suddenly in a local hospital on June 8.

He was born in Boston, Mass., on February 19, 1901, the son of Wolf and Anna (Fine) Lipsky. He attended the Bangor schools and graduated from Harvard Dental College. He practiced dentistry in Bangor for many years.

He served actively in World War II, both in Europe and in Asia. He retired a Lt. Colonel. He was greatly interested in music and was a member of the Habernicht Quartet, the Bangor Symphony Orchestra, the Bangor Band and the Anah Temple Shrine Band.

He is survived by a son, Stephen Lipsky of East Hills, N. Y., and a daughter, Mrs. Albert Barr of Seoul, Korea, and a sister Mrs. Keith Goldsmith of Rockland, and a brother, George Lipsky of Bangor, and six grandchildren.
