## Mrs. Solomon, Former Local Resident, Dies

Mrs. Anne Solomon, 74, of New York City, formerly of Bangor, died Saturday at a Staten Island, N. Y., hospital. She was the wife of Sam Solomon.

Mrs. Solomon came from Russia 55 years ago and lived in Bangor for several years, and since visited here annually. She was a member of the Malvine Kroll Auxiliary, Brooklyn Jewish Hospital for Chronic Diseases; the Staten Island Community Center, the Hadassah and Congregation Anshe Chesed, New Brighton.

Surviving, besides her husband, who resides in New York City, are a son, Morris Solomon of Sacramento, Calif.; a daughter, Mrs. Maurice Alpert of Bangor; eight grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

A service was conducted in the Central Funeral Chapel on Staten Island Sunday with the Rabbi Morris Zachariash officiating. Committal services will be held Thursday noon in the Beth Israel Synagogue Cemetery here with Rabbi A. H. Freedman of Congregation Beth Israel officiating.
