Abraham Stern, Noted Bangor Attorney, Dies

Abraham J. Stern, 57, of 42 Norfolk Street, attorney and solicitor for the City of Bangor for 19 years, died Jan. 2 in a local hospital following a long illness.

He was born in Bangor, the son of Hyman and Mamie (Lipsky) Stern.

He graduated from the University of Maine in 1934 with Phi Beta Kappa honors and graduated from the Harvard University Law School in 1937. He was a member of the American, Maine and Penobscot County Bar Associations and the American Trial Lawyers Association.

He was very active in numerous civic, Masonic and fraternal orders and was past president of the Harvard Club of Eastern Maine.

He was a member of Congregation Beth Israel and Congregation Beth Abraham.

Surviving are: two brothers, Edward Stern of Bangor, and Herbert Stern of Portland; a sister, Miss Edith M. Stern, of Bangor; several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held today at 1 p. m. in the Jewish Funeral Chapel, Center Street, with Rabbi Irving Margolies of Congregation Beth Israel officiating.
