JACKSONVILLE, FLA. — Bernard Sass, 89, passed away Tuesday, May 16, 2000, at Memorial Medical Center, Jacksonville.



Mr. Sass was professor of Anatomy and Physiology at the University of Maine, Orono, for 34 years. He was a graduate of City College, N.Y. in 1934 and from Columbia University with a Masters in 1936. He was a member of Mechanics Masonic Lodge No. 66 of Orono, Scottish Rite Bodies and an Emeritus member of the Legion of Honor at the Morocco Shrine Temple, Jacksonville. Mr. Sass was drafted into the Army and then assigned to the Air Force.

He was predeceased by his first wife in 1975, Gertrude Hollander Sass; and a son, Scott Sass. He is survived by his present wife, Grace Bradley Sass; two sons, Eric Sass of Reston, Va., Brian Sass of Peru; three stepsons, which he considered his sons, Robert Boone of California, David Boone of Oregon, Ronnie Boone of Jacksonville, Fla.; a brother, Bill Sass; a sister, Helen Latz, both of New York; nine grandchildren, one great-granddaughter.
