David Braidy, Noted Bangor Merchant, Dies

David Braidy, 78, of 138 Birch Street, a well known local businessman died early Tuesday morning.

He was born in Russia, but came to the United States as a young man and founded the David Braidy Clothing Company. He was a member of Congregation Beth Israel, B'nai B'rith and the Jewish Community Center. Mr. Braidy was a life member of the Zionist Organization of America.
