Frank Glazier, Clare's Store Proprietor, Dies

Frank Glazier, 62, of 24 Fruit Street, Bangor, died unexpectedly Jan. 16 in a Boston, Mass., hospital. He was born in Bangor May 31, 1909, the son of Morris and Rachel (Gamdina) Glazier.

He was the proprietor of Clare's Store in Downtown Bangor and a member of Congregation Beth Israel, Bangor, St. Andrews Lodge, AF and AM, Scottish Rite Bodies, 32nd Degree, Maine Consistory, Portland, and Anah Temple, Order of the Mystic Shrine.

From 1964 to 1966 he served as a Democratic representative to the Maine State Legislature.

He is survived by his wife, Marcella (Shapiro) Glazier, Bangor; a son, Alan N. Glazier, Bangor; three sisters, Mrs. Mary Levy, Mrs. Anna Leavitt and Mrs. Estelle Rich, all of Bangor.

Funeral services will be held today at 12 noon at the Jewish Funeral Chapel, Center Street, Bangor. Interment will be in Beth Israel Cemetery, Bangor. Memorial week will be observed at 24 Fruit Street.
