BANGOR — George Alan Lipsky, 76, died Oct. 20, 1982, at an Orono convalescent center after a brief illness. He was born in Bangor, Nov. 20, 1905, the son of Wolf E. and Annie (Fine) Lipsky. Mr. Lipsky was a graduate of Bangor High School, the University of Maine at Orono, and studied merchandising in New York.
