

Harvey Budner Brandwein president of Sterns, dies

Harvey Budner Brandwein, 55, president of Sterns Department Stores, Inc., for the past 15 years, died Friday at his home following a long illness. He was born in New York City, N.Y., Sept. 13, 1929, son of Arthur and Selma Brandwein.

He graduated from Columbia Grammar School in New York City, Wesley College of Delaware, New York University School of Retailing and Filene's Executive Training Program.
