Harry L. Goldstein, 72, of 179 Essex Street, Bangor, died unexpectedly July 20 at a local hospital. Born in Boston, Mass., Oct. 1, 1898, he was the son of Emanuel and Rebecca Goldstein.

In his earlier years he was the proprietor of the former Aroostook House on Washington Street and in later years ran the Richardson Variety Store on Exchange Street, retiring in 1967. He was a graduate of Bangor High School, class of 1918, and attended the University of Maine.

A U.S. Army veteran of World Wat I, he was a member of the James W. Williams Post, American Legion; the Bangor Lodge, BPOE; Congregation Beth Israel; B'nai B'rith Lodge and the Zionist organization.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Lillian (Richardson) Goldstein, Bangor; a daughter, Mrs. Donald (Janice) Povich, Bath; a son, Marvin H. Goldstein, Hopkinton, Mass.; a brother, Samuel Goldstein, Brookline, Mass.; two grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at the Jewish Funeral Chapel, Center St., Bangor, today at 1 p.m. with Rabbi Henry Isaacs officiating. Interment will be in Beth Israel Cemetery. Memorial week will be observed at 179 Essex Street, Bangor.
