BANGOR - Hanna Nachum, 95 died Wednesday, Aug. 16, 2000, at a local health-care facility surrounded by her loving family. Hanna was the only daughter of Henriette and Richard Hesse. She was born in Zurich, Switzerland on March 28, 1905.

The family lived in Hamburg, Germany, where Hanna graduated from school and pursued a career as a bookkeeper for a shipping expediting company. In 1928, she married Martin Nachum. The political situation in 1930s Germany resulted in the upheaval of their lives. Hanna and Martin, with their two children, emigrated to the U.S. in 1939, settling in Bangor. In Bangor, Hanna worked as a forelady at Viner Bros: She graciously balanced being a professional, as well as homemaker and exceptional wife and mother. In later years, she worked at the Standard Youth Center and as a volunteer at EMMC. She overcame adversity numerous times throughout the years and was deeply admired for her courage by all who knew and loved her. Friends, young and old, cherished her warmth, wisdom and the caring she showed toward all. She also enjoyed baking, knitting, her flowers, concerts, traveling and being with her family and friends.

She was predeceased by her husband and life partner, Martin Nachum; her brother, Alex Hesse; her son-in-law, David Baye.
