

Hyman Share, Grocer, Dead

Hyman Share, of 49 Pine Street, a Bangor business man for more than 50 years, died at a local hospital Tuesday morning following a long illness.

Mr. Share was born in Russia and came to Nashua, N. H., as a young man. He later moved to Bangor, where he conducted a grocery store on Pine Street.

Besides his wife, Mrs. Sadie Share, he is survived by four daughters, Mrs. Gertrude Hartstone and Mrs. Freida Miller, both of Bangor, Mrs. Irene Gersten of Middle Village, N. Y., and Mrs. Fannie Reiss of Brooklyn, N. Y.; by two sons, Charles Share of Bangor and Samuel Share of Portsmouth, N. H.; by a brother, Irving Shrier of New York City. Also surviving are 15 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held this morning at 11 o'clock at the Jewish Chapel, Center Street. Rabbi A. H. Freedman of the Beth Israel Synagogue, of which Mr. Share was a member, will officiate.
