The death of Mrs. Helen Goldsmith Stone, 48, widow of Julius Stone, occurred here Saturday at her home, 185 Norfolk Street.

Mrs. Stone was born in Bangor June 17, 1920, the daughter of Arthur J. and Eva (Goldberg) Goldsmith.

She was president and owner of the Standard Electric Company of Bangor and Portland.
