H. D. Sterns,

Dead At 52

WATERVILLE — Herbert D. Sterns, 52, of Johnson Heights, died Nov. 11 at a Waterville hospital. He was vice president of Sterns Inc. of Waterville and Skowhegan.

Sterns was born in Hartland March 11, 1919, the son of the late Harry and Bessie Sterns.

He graduated in 1941 from Colby College and went on to obtain a Harvard University master's degree in 1942. He was a World War II veteran, serving in the Army from 1942-46 and seeing Pacific Theatre action.

He was a member of Waterville Masons; Teconnet Ch. Royal Arch Masons; Scottish Rite Bodies of Augusta and Portland; Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston; and Lebanon Council Royal and Select Masters.

Mr. Sterns was also a member of B'nai B'rith, Zionist Organization of America, and was past president of Beth Israel Synagogue, Waterville; Waterville Kiwanis Club; director of the Waterville area C of C; member of the AL post of Waterville; and a member of the Association of Men's Sportswear Buyers.

Mr. Sterns is survived by his widow, Myra B. Sterns, and three daughters, Ellen, Marsha and Debra, all of Waterville; brother, Fred of Skowhegan.

Services will be held 9:30 a.m. Friday at Beth Israel, Waterville, also at the Beth Israel Cemetery in Bangor.
