CUTLER, Israel R., age 88, died August 13 at the Eastern Maine Medical Center. Born in Russia August 17, 1894, the son of Edwin and Rachel Cutler, he lived in Old Town for 75 years and for 65 years was active as owner of Cutler's Womens Shop. He was a member of the Masons, the Orono - Old Town Shrine Club, Temple Israel, the Old Town Rotary Club of which he was a charter member. He was also a member of the Bangor Jewish Community Center, a life member of the Portland Jewish Home for the Aged, and a charter member of the Bangor Chapter of B'Nai B'Rith.
