

LILLIAN (RICHARDSON) GOLDSTEIN

BANGOR — Lillian (Richardson) Goldstein, 84, died Dec. 20, 1989, at an Orono nursing home. Mrs. Goldstein was born in Bangor, July 23, 1905, the daughter of John L. and Ethel (Cohen) Richardson, and graduated from Bangor High School. A well-known businesswoman, she and her husband, the late Harry Z. Goldstein, whom she married in 1928, owned and operated Richardson's Confectionary Company of Bangor until his death in 1971. Richardson's Confectionary Company was founded by Mrs. Goldstein's father in the early 1900's. Mrs. Goldstein was a lifelong member of Congregation Beth Israel of Bangor. She was a past president of B'nai B'rith and of Hadassah, and an active participant in the Democratic Party in Bangor for many years. A son, Marvin H. Goldstein, predeceased her in October of 1985. She is survived by one daughter, Janice Povich of Bath; and two grandchildren. A funeral will be held 1 p.m. Friday, Dec. 22, 1989, at the Jewish Funeral Chapel, Center Street, Bangor, with Rabbi Joseph Schoenberger officiating. Arrangements are by Brookings-Smith, Bangor.
