

Leo Plesset, Former Grocer, Dead At 77

Leo Plesset, 77, died Friday morning at a Bangor hospital following an illness of three weeks.

He was born in Ukraine, Russia, the son of Rabbi and Mrs. Joshua Plesset. He was in business in Fort Kent for 30 years, prior to moving to Bangor 16 years ago. He had been engaged in the grocery business in Bangor. He was a longtime member of the Masonic Lodge of Fort Kent, and the Beth Israel Synagogue of Bangor.
