

Prominent Waterville Doctor Dies

WATERVILLE (AP)—Dr. Moses Freed Lubell, chief radiologist at Thayer Hospital, died Wednesday. He was 59.

He was a graduate of Harvard and the College of Physicians and Surgeons in New York City. He had practiced in Waterville since 1931.

He leaves a son, David S., a student at New York University Medical School, and a daughter, Elizabeth, a student at Jackson College, Medford, Mass.

The remains were brought to Bangor where funeral services will be held this afternoon at 1 o'clock at the Jewish Chapel on Center Street.
