

### MORRIS DAVID RUBIN

BANGOR and OLD ORCHARD BEACH - Morris D. Rubin, 83, of Bangor and Old Orchard Beach, died suddenly June 22, 1999, in Old Orchard. Born in Bangor, Mr. Rubin was the son of Sam and Sophie (Levine) Rubin.



He was a graduate of the University of Maine and Columbia University School of Law. He was sworn into the Maine Bar Association on the same day, he was inducted into the U.S. Army. Mr. Rubin was on active duty serving overseas in World War II and returned to Bangor, where he was a member of the Maine Bar Association and a practicing attorney for more than 50 years. Mr. Rubin had a firm commitment to his community and synagogues and was an active member of B'Nai Brith, Bangor Jewish Community Council of which he was a past president, American Legion and the Bangor Kiwanis. Most recently he was a member of RSVP and assisted at the Sweetser School in Saco. Throughout his life, Mr. Rubin was a member of the Beth Israel Congregations in Bangor and Old Orchard.

Mr. Rubin leaves behind his wife, Elaine Rubin of Bangor and Old Orchard Beach; his children, Renee and her husband, Alfred Newcomb of Massachusetts, Barbara Rubin of Connecticut, Fay Rubin of New Hampshire.
