BANGOR — Morris Herman Shafmaster, 88, husband of the late Anna Pauline (Cohen) Shafmaster, died July 29, 1988, at a Brewer health-care center. He was born in Haverhill, Mass., Nov. 30, 1899, son of Nathan and Jenny (Sandler) Shafmaster. He was the founder and owner of the former Enterprise Shoe Store on Main Street in Bangor for 65 years. He was a 66-year member of the Bangor Elks and a past exalted ruler. He was the emcee for many local minstrel shows held at City Hall and for the Elks Club; also he used to do many of the radio shows for Nissen Bakery. He was a member of the Congregation Beth Israel and the B'nai B'rith. Surviving are one daughter, Barbara Sucher; one son, Sumner H. Shafmaster, both of North Miami Beach, Fla.; four grandchildren; one great-granddaughter; two sisters, Charlotte Bass of Lowell, Mass., and Lillian Burrows of Norwood, Mass. He was predeceased by a brother, Harry Shafmaster; and two sisters, Sadie Baron and Bernice Abramson.
