

## MOLLIE STERN

BANGOR — Mollie Stern, 86, wife of the late Judge Edward Stern, died Nov. 18, 1995. She was born in Bangor, May 27, 1909, the daughter of Sam and Sophia Rubin. Mollie graduated from Bangor High School, Gorham Normal School, Class of 1929, and the University of Maine, Class of 1932, where she received the M Award. She was once appointed to the Maine School Building Authority by Governor Curtis. Mollie was one-time on the Board of Directors for Unity College. She was a life member of Hadassah; a member of the Beth Israel Sisterhood American Association of University Women; Bangor Historical Society and Bangor Symphony Women. Mollie was an active Democrat, well known as a fastidious cook, ru hooker, needlepointer, and collector of antiques. Mollie's high standards were reflected in everything she did. Most evident was her love for Maine, Bangor and its people. She lost her favorite son, Attorney Marshall Stern, in June to an automobile accident. She is survived by her much loved, bizarre son, Deane Stern; and brilliant attorney, brother Morris Rubin; two charming grandchildren, Marchelle Zofi Stern and Jason Stern; daughter-in-law, Donna Stern; nieces, nephews and cousins; and closest of family-like friends, Tom Viner, Linda Wakefield and recently Grace Stewart. Funeral services will be held 12 noon Monday at the Beth Israel Synagogue, York Street, Bangor, with Rabbi Joseph Schonberger officiating. Interment will be in Beth Israel Cemetery.
