

Former City Merchant Dead At 77

Myer P. Friedman, 77, of Bangor, residing in Portland the past year, died at the Maine Medical Center there Sunday afternoon.

Born in New York City the son of Joseph and Rose Friedman, he was proprietor of an Exchange Street men's clothing store here many years ago and later was employed at the Friedman Furniture Company. He retired several years ago.

Surviving are two sons, Albert of Bangor and Jack of Old Town; a daughter, Mrs. Dorothy St. Germain of Bangor; two brothers, Adolph B. of Bangor and Moses of Lewiston; a sister, Mrs. Benjamin Oppenheim of Bangor.

Funeral services will be held at the Jewish Chapel on Center Street, Bangor, this afternoon at 1 o'clock. Rabbi A. H. Freedman will officiate. Burial will be at Beth Israel Cemetery, Bangor.
