BANGOR - Nathan Kobritz, 84, died Sept. 23, 2003, at a local hospital. He was born July 27, 1919, in Bangor, the son of Morris and Eva (Tinus) Kobritz.



The highlight of Nathan's life was being a World War II Veteran, fighting four years in Guadalcanal and being awarded a Purple Heart. Since his brother's death, he was the sole owner of the Oronoka Restaurant, where he was known for his storytelling and humor. His passion was following the Red Sox.

He is survived by two sons, Jordan Kobritz of Prescott Valley, Ariz., Aalan Kobritz of New York City, N.Y.; one daughter, Sharon Kobritz of Bangor. He was predeceased by his beloved brother, John.
