N. L. Rothschild, Local Merchant, Is Dead At 51

Norman L. Rothschild, 51, of 242 Nowell Road, Bangor, a prominent businessman in this community, died Wednesday in Boston following an extended period of ill health.

He was born in Brooklyn, N. Y., August 27, 1913.

Mr. Rothschild owned and operated Burdell's Fashion Store at 91 Main Street. Prior to his illness he was president of the Bangor Merchants Bureau and a long standing member of Beth Israel Synagogue, B'nai B'rith and the Jewish Community Center.

Surviving are his mother, Mrs. Harry Rothschild of New York; his wife, Violet of Bangor; a son, Michael of Bangor; a daughter, Mrs. Karen Siebert of Bangor; two brothers, Jess of Brooklyn, N. Y., and Marton of Trumbull, Conn.; a sister, Mrs. Janet Karson of Great Neck, N. Y.
