BANGOR — Philip N. Koritzky, 89, of Bradford Commons, Bangor, died Jan. 20, 1988, at a Bangor hospital. He was born in Rockland, May 8, 1898, the son of Nathan and Lizzie (Klipatoky) Koritzky. He was a well-known auto body repairman and the owner of the Bangor Auto Body Shop and Koritzky's Garage. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War I, the James W.
