Rudolph Brill, Former Bangor Resident, Dies

Rudolph E. Brill, 86, of Florida, formerly of Bangor, died in New York unexpectedly Thursday.

He was born in Lithuania March 25, 1882. He was associated with the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company of Bangor for many years. Mr. Brill was a member of the Beth Israel Synagogue, B'nai B'rith, the Zionist organization, and was a former member of the Toldos Itzchock. He was a cantor at the Coral Gables Hotel in Coral Gables, Fla.
