Rena Miller Of Bangor Is Dead At 66

Mrs. Rena Miller, 66, of 114 Parkview Avenue, died Wednesday morning at her residence.

She was born in Russia, Sept. 20, 1900, the daughter of Samuel and Razel Pinsky. She was a former owner of Miller's Restaurant in Bangor. A member of the Beth Israel Synagogue, she also was active in Hadasah; the B'nai B'rith Auxiliary; the Sisterhood of Beth Israel Synagogue; and the auxiliaries of the Bangor City and Eastern Maine General Hospitals.

Surviving are her husband, Meyer Miller of Bangor; two sons, Sanford of Bangor and Robert of Baltimore, Md.; seven grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.
