Samul E. Cummings, 87, of 160 Essex St., a well-known Bangor store owner, died Tuesday at a local nursing home after a brief illness. He was the husband of Mrs. Lillian (Golden) Cummings.

Born in Russia on Oct. 15. 1881, Mr. Cummings was the son of Simon and Sarah (Minkin) Kominsky.

Mr. Cummings was a businessman in the Bangor area for more than 65 years. He owned and operated the Outlet on Main St., later renamed Everybody's Store.

He was a member of the Beth Israel Synagogue, B'nai B'rith Lodge and the Jewish Home for the Aged Portland
