

Samuel M. Cutler, 93

OLD TOWN — Samuel M. Cutler, 93, died Friday. He was born in Russia in 1890 and immigrated to Old Town in 1898.

He was a graduate of Old Town High School, where he played on the basketball team.

After service with the U.S. Army in World War I, he went to work for his father at the Edwin Cutler Co. He worked there until 1980.

Actively involved in the community,

he was a charter member of the Old Town Elks Club, the Rotary and the Odd Fellows. He was a member of the Star of the East Lodge AF & AM and the Anah Temple Shrine. He was a member of the Congregation Beth Israel in Bangor and the Bangor Jewish Community Center.

At age 78 he began developing safety equipment for loggers and earned a citation from the logging association for his work.
