## Sidney B. Paul, Noted Bangor Merchant, Dies

Sidney B. Paul, 63, husband of Georgia Paul, died unexpectedly January 15 at a local hospital. A Bangor resident since 1910, he was a partner in the John Paul Clothing Store in Bangor.

He was born in Boston, Mass., the son of John and Dora (Baitler) Paul, and was a member of the Beth Israel Synagogue in Bangor. Mr. Paul was a member of the Bangor Art Society and a supporter of other cultural activities in the Bangor area, especially the Bangor Symphony. He was a member of the Pinewood Country Club and Anah Temple, Order of the Mystic Shrine.

Besides his wife, he is survived by a son, Jonathan, of Bangor; a brother, Henry, of Bangor; and three sisters: Mrs. Hyman Levin, Irvington, N.J., Mrs. Abraham Weinstein, Brookline, Mass., and Mrs. Maynard Hinden, Sharon, Mass.
