NEWPORT—William Shapiro, 73, died Sunday morning at a Togus hospital.

He was born in Austria August 19, 1891, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Nathan Shapiro.

Mr. Shapiro was a veteran of World War I and was past commander of the Newport American Legion Post, and was a member of the Odd Fellows Lodge. He was in business for himself in Newport prior to his retirement.
